

GCCA School Supply List: **Seventh-Eighth Grade**

Our first day of school will run more smoothly if you would bring all supplies to Meet the Teacher Day. If you can't come that day, bring them to the first day of class. Please bring only the necessary supplies to school. Other supplies will be provided by the school (e.g. planner).

Backpack should have a simple pattern, no wheels, and be large enough to fit a full-size folder and books/study guides. Students must also bring a large water bottle to keep in class and drink from throughout the day.

***Label these items with your name.*

Turn in to your teacher:

- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 packs of college-ruled notebook paper
- 1 pack of computer paper
- 3 packs of 3x5 lined index cards
- 48 Count Ticonderoga #2 pencils (sharpened)
- 8 pack ULTRA FINE TIP dry erase markers
- **3 sturdy plastic folders (inside must have 2 pockets and 3 prongs)

Student's Personal Supplies:

- **ESV Bible (Any edition or style will work, but the translation must be ESV.)
- **1 ½ " binder with 5 divider tabs (We will label tabs at school.)
- **1" binder for Latin/Greek w/ 5 divider tabs inside (We will label tabs at school.)
- **Small box to organize flashcards (Try the Dollar Tree.)
- **3 subject spiral notebook w/ college ruled paper (at least 150 sheets). This will be used all year for history and literature.
- **1 college-ruled composition journal (thick paper if possible). This will be used all year as a composition portfolio; the better quality, the more likely it will last all year. I would not buy the hardback kind as these are not the most comfortable for writing inside.
- Scientific calculator (TI-30XIIS suggested but any is fine)
- Compass and protractor (\$5 on Amazon)
- **Ruler with centimeters and inches
- 1 pencil box/pouch with the following inside:
 - 2 large pink erasers
 - 3 red pens (save a few extra at home to replace)
 - 3 black or blue ink ballpoint pens (Please get pens that do not bleed through pages or have liquid ink. We are using these to annotate books, so they must be light and tidy pens. In this case, cheaper styles are usually better :)
 - Set of colored pencils or twistables
 - Set of Bic Pastel Highlighters for literature class (BIC Highlighter Grip Pastel, Highlighter Pens with Adjustable Chisel Tip, Rubber Grip for Extra Comfort, Assorted Colours, Pack of 6)
- **Math Binder according to these specifications
 - 1/2" binder with sleeve in the front (to insert lesson plan schedule)
 - 200 sheets loose leaf graph paper
 - 2 dividers
 - 5 plastic page protectors
