

GCCA School Supply List: **Fifth-Sixth Grade**

Our first day of school will run more smoothly if you would bring all supplies to Meet the Teacher Day. If you can't come that day, bring them to the first day of class. Please bring only the necessary supplies to school. Other supplies will be provided by the school (e.g. planner).

Backpack should have a simple pattern, no wheels, and be large enough to fit a full-size folder and books/study guides. Please no hanging key chains. Students must also bring a large water bottle to keep in class and drink from throughout the day.

***Label these items with your name.*

Turn in to your teacher:

- 2 boxes of tissues
- 3 pack of paper towels
- 2 packs of wide-ruled notebook paper
- 1 pack of computer paper
- 3 packs of 3x5 lined index cards
- 60 Count Ticonderoga #2 pencils (sharpened)
- 8 pack ULTRA FINE TIP dry erase markers

Put these items in your desk:

- ****1 sturdy 1" white binder with insertable clear pockets on the outside. (This will travel back and forth daily as it will house the student planner and graded papers.)**
- ****Small box to organize flashcards (Try the Dollar Tree.)**
- ****Ruler with centimeters and inches**
- ****1 pencil box with the following inside:**
 - 3 large pink erasers
 - 2 yellow highlighters (keep extra at home to replace)
 - 2 red pens (keep extra at home to replace)
 - 24 colored pencils or twistables
- ****Math Binder according to these specifications**
 - 1/2" binder with sleeve in the front (to insert lesson plan schedule)
 - 200 sheets loose leaf graph paper
 - 2 dividers
 - 5 plastic page protectors
- Scientific calculator (TI-30XIIS suggested but any is fine)
- Compass and protractor (\$5 on Amazon)

Keep at Home:

- 1 sturdy 2" binder (This is used to store quizzes, tests, and other assignments. Graded assignments will be sent home in the students 1" binder. It is the responsibility of the students to file these graded assignments into their larger binder.)
- Place in binder: 8 pack of notebook dividers with tabs labeled as follows: Latin, Literature, Spelling, Composition, History, Geography, Christian Studies, Science
