

Gulf Coast Classical Academy Admissions Process 727-447-2756

1. School Tour & Introduction Meeting

Attend an Open House or schedule a private tour. Meet with the Head of School discuss the school's classical mission, Christian values, and family and student expectations.

2. Submit Required Documents

Submit application (online) and application fee (mail to GCCA or drop off at school office), report card from previous and current school year, attendance and behavior records, standardized test scores, and any other pertinent documentation (current and past IEP's, health records, etc). Download and email GCCA the completed Release of Records form for the collection of full records for each child applying. Have a teacher submit online the student recommendation form.

3. Visitation & Assessment

Once all records and recommendations have been received, your child will then be invited to shadow our school for two-three days. During their visit, they will be assessed for math, reading, and writing readiness.

4. Admission Decision

After the admissions team has reviewed all documentation, the visitation days, and the assessment data, the Head of School will contact the family concerning the school's decision.

If our staff and teachers, you as parents, and your child all agree that GCCA is in fact the best place for them to continue their education, we will then support you in our school's enrollment process.

An enrollment meeting between Parents and the Head of School will be scheduled to further discuss school policy, the student code of conduct, statement of faith, and aligning your family's home life with our school's guidelines and expectations. Parents will sign our enrollment contract and submit the required school registration fee.
